

# Citizenship

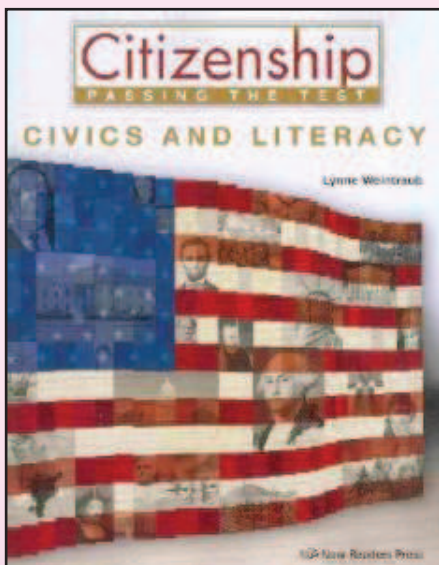
Assist in preparing women to become informed citizens of the United States.
